The ABC of Iowa Safety Award of Excellence

The ABC of Iowa Safety Award of Excellence is presented to the contractor who demonstrates safety excellence through company programs, employee training, pre-work planning, and safe work practices.

One contractor will be awarded from each of the following categories:

- 1. Under 50,000 hours worked;
2. 50,0001 to 200,000 hours worked; and
3. Over 200,000 hours worked.

To be considered for this award, companies from categories 2 and 3 must have incident rates for total OSHA Recordables and Lost Work Day Cases at least 25% better than their industry average.

Award Requirements

To Be Considered for This Award, You Must do the Following:

- 1. Complete a 2021 STEP Application by 9/1/2021
2. Complete this form honestly and in its entirety
3. Submit this form and your OSHA Form 300A (if over 10 employees) to the ABC of Iowa Safety Department by 10/1/2021
